## Wado Pentecost Seminar 2024 in Berlin Living tradition in Wado Ryu

110 Wado karateka from Austria, Belgium, Finland and Germany and a large group from Hungary met for the traditional Wado Pentecost Seminar 2024 in Berlin. The seminar was led by Shuzo Imai, 9<sup>th</sup> Dan Wado Ryu, Takamasa Arakawa, 6<sup>th</sup> Dan JKF Wado-Kai, Bernd Alscher, 7<sup>th</sup> Dan Wado Ryu, and Christina Gutz, 7<sup>th</sup> Dan Wado Ryu.

This Wado seminar was characterized by high motivation and concentration of all participants and by the fun that participants and instructors shared during the entire seminar.

## Living tradition in Wado Ryu

Wado Ryu was founded by Hironori Otsuka (1892 - 1982). In 1939 it was registered in the Dai Nippon Butokukai in Kyoto, and in 1942 the Wado Ryu curriculum was supplemented by Otsuka under the title "Technical System of Wadoryu".

At this year's Wado Pentecost Seminar, the diversity of Wado ryu was taught by Imai, Arakawa, Gutz and Alscher: kihon, kata with kaisetsu, idori, kihon kumite, kumite gata, ohyo kumite, tanto dori and jiyu kumite. The "common thread" of the seminar followed by the four senseis were essential principles of Wado Ryu such as sente,ilrimi, tai sabaki, san-mi-ittai, tai otoshi and chushin tadasu. Always present was the ability to act out of relaxation, which is an important prerequisite for flowing, dynamic, fast and effective techniques. It was a particular pleasure to welcome Takamasa Arakawa back to Berlin after five years. He provided the participants with in-depth knowledge of the kata and kaisetsu of the kata Naihanchi, Chinto, Wanshu and Niseishi. Arakawa was also able to inspire with his self-defense training and his kumite exercises for competition.

It was great to deepen friendships, make new contacts, exchange ideas and train together at this Wado Pentecost Seminar.
